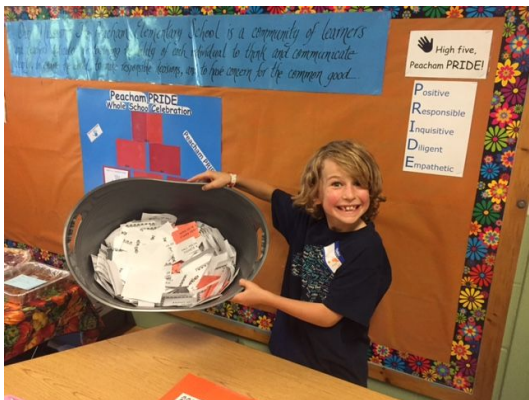
#### **Dogs**
