

Notice to Residents of Peacham School District

Legal voters of Peacham, Vermont who are interested in serving on the School Board are hereby notified that they may submit their own name for placement on the ballot for election of school board members.

The Legislature has waived the requirement for candidates to collect petitions from town residents in order to be placed on the ballot; you simply have to apply to have your name placed on the ballot.

In 2021, there are two school board seats open – a 2-year seat and a three-year seat. If you would like to be on the ballot for the two-year seat *or* for the three-year seat, you will need to submit an application for each.

*** The Peacham School Board has voted to move all 2021 school district voting to Australian Ballot. All articles including the school budget and school board elections will be done by ballot. There will be no voting on the floor. This decision reflects the fact that restrictions on public gatherings caused by the Covid-19 pandemic will likely still be in place in March 2021. The Legislature granted the authority to District School Boards to move all of their school district articles to Australian ballot for the 2021 voting.
